Measuring Your Countertops

Providing us with measurements of your existing countertops will help streamline the estimating process. Using the second page of this document, simply draw out the shapes of your existing countertops and record the dimensions of each side. Don't worry, they don't have to be exact. This process is solely for estimating purposes - we will come to your home to take precise measurements prior to fabricating your new countertops. Here are some tips to help you get started:

Measuring Your Countertops

- Carefully draw the shape of each of your countertops
- Use a tape measure to measure the length and width of each piece and record in inches
- Measurements should be recorded to the nearest half inch
- If your countertops will have stone backslashes, please label these pieces with a "BS"
- Include the desired height of all splashes
- If your countertops have radial curves be sure and include these in your drawing
- Include the overhang width on islands (distance from cabinet to edge of top)

What to Include

- Cooktop/Range (Please indicate model if known)
- Cut outs for sinks. Please indicate which type of sink you will have with your new tops (i.e. drop in or undermount)
- Dishwasher placement
- Refrigerator placement
- Pictures of your existing tops (if possible)
- Plans of new tops (if available)

Once you have finished recording your measurements you can either email your measurements to us or bring them into our showroom. In order to complete your estimate we will need to know what type of material you want. Our showroom specialists will be happy to go over material choices with you in our southeast Austin showroom.
